### SUMMER MISSION OPPORTUNITY

Praise God! We have been approved under Canada Summer Jobs to hire 1 person for 9 weeks, and 3 children's workers for 6 weeks, all at \$15 per hour based on 40 hours per week. To be eligible for the summer worker program the applicant must be between the ages of 15 and 30, must be a full-time student before and after the work.

Our hope is to have a team that would prepare a Vacation Bible School program and go out to the churches to help with the teaching and leading while



working alongside local volunteers. Some other areas of local involvement to help the church may also be involved.

The benefit of this would be an opportunity to serve God and the conference as a practical mission experience. It would be helpful in developing gifts and ability and encourage spiritual growth. If you are interested, please con-

tact us and provide your personal testimony, why you want to do this and what you could bring to the team. A letter of reference and affirmation from your pastor will be required from successful applicants.

Our cost would be a bit over \$3000 to make up the gap in the grant and promised wage, plus funds needed for travel expenses.

If your congregation is interested, please let us know. The local church would need to provide some volunteers, billeting/meals for the team and cover the cost of materials needed locally.
